ACTION TAKEN:

On 092206 at approximately 2123 hours, I heard Officers Wesel and Schuster get dispatched to a suicidal male at 135 Lincoln St. #20. At that time I was southbound on Interstate 5 coming from the Medford area. I then heard Sergeant Selby state that she would be en route as well.

As I approached the area of Phoenix, I heard an unknown officer call for Sergeant Williams to respond. I also heard the officer say to expedite. At that point I activated my emergency lights and began to respond to the area. I messaged to dispatch that I was responding to the call on Lincoln St. I was approaching the Talent city limits, still on I-5.

Sergeant Selby then got onto the radio and stated that they needed to force entry. She then radioed to Sergeant Williams to bring a sledge hammer. At this point I activated my siren and upgraded my response.

When I was approaching the Ashland city limits I heard Sergeant Williams state that officers had forced entry. I then heard Officer Wesel request Ashland Fire and Rescue (AFR) respond to the scene code 3. At that point I deactivated my siren and emergency lights and continued to the scene at a reduced code.
