

and pertinent items. I located two Albertson's receipts for the purchase of "Unisom" and one receipt from Safeway for the purchase of wine. All the receipts were dated 01-22-06. One of the Albertson's receipts showed two boxes of Unisom purchased with cash and the other receipt showed two boxes purchased with a debit card. One Albertson's receipt was found on the floor and the Safeway and other Albertson's receipts were found in Hanson's wallet.

In the garbage can in the kitchen is where Officer Schuster found the boxes to the Unisom bottles. On the front was a picture of a blue gel-liquid filled capsule. This is when we realized the substance that was everywhere was most likely Unisom. There was a large mug on the counter that had the substance in it along with a large spatula in the sink that had blue gel on it. It looked like the spatula had been used to crush all the gels in the mug, leaving a liquid behind. Officer Schuster and I then left; Koenigsberg locked the door behind us.

I returned to the station where I was then advised the Major Assault Death Unit (MADU) had been called by the Jackson County Medical Examiner and they were on their way to interview all of us. Ashland Detective Jensen had already arrived at the station prior to my returning. I met with him and handed over all the items I had secured including the business card for Koenigsberg. I gave the camera to Officer Vanderlip who printed the pictures I took and supplied the detectives with a copy.

Not long after returning to the station Officer Schuster, Sgt. Selby and I were introduced to Detective Young of Medford and Detective Hobbs of Jackson County by Detective Jensen. They briefed us that they were going to need to interview each of us and take some photos of our hands. Detective Hobbs conducted and recorded my interview. My hands were later photographed by Detective Young.

I then met with a team member from a Critical Incident group to insure I was feeling okay about the day's events. We talked briefly and I returned to the report writing room, where I then learned the detectives wanted me to return to the apartment again to point out certain pertinent items and items that had been moved. I retrieved the key from Koenigsberg with Detective Jensen. We then met Sgt. Selby, Detective Young and Detective Hobbs at the apartment. We all went 'in and I explained the layout. I then returned to the station with Detective Jensen and finished for the evening. I returned to work on 01-23-06 at 1430 hours where I completed my report.
