Patient Narrative

approx 136 BPM, pt was not talking by was breathing. Attempts at gaining a B/P was difficult due to pt's arm restrained by handcuffs, hand cuffs where removed off of L hand, had to replaced with "Posey" strap but with room for B/P cuff. Pt kept flexing and then started to seize causing a B/P to be unobtainable.

Suicide attempt

Initial assessment, searched home for meds, and possible chemicals used, called on line medical control at RVMC spoke with Dr. Corey, pt was placed on flat, carried to medic, V.S., EKG monitor, O2 therapy, IV, started, transported to RVMC code 3, pt was placed in ER RM #1, pt's glasses given to nurses.

Addendum: added 02/02/2006 by Marshall Rasor

1200cc of normal saline was given to pt via 16 gu. IV access prior to arrival at hospital. A pulse was felt for and found after first and second seizure. After third seizure pt status was checked via chest rise and fall, and sinus tach. on monitor. Added to report is another ECG documentation page showing times and HR while monitor was attached to pt. Monitor was disconnected and turned off prior to pt being unloaded from the back of the medic unit at RVMC.
